Youth Collective Online

Using Zoom and Discord

As a member of Youth Collective Online you have access to artist-led online workshops via Zoom, and a dedicated social platform on Discord for extending discussion outside of the session and talking all things creative.

We've outlined what to expect when using the online platforms here...

Zoom

- Workshops will be held on Zoom (www.zoom.us) which is a free online platform. A Zoom account isn't required to attend a session and anyone can join using the mobile apps or desktop apps. To watch how to join see the YouTube tutorial [here](#).
- To attend the sessions you will be asked to sign-up via a link provided in the newsletters. Following this you will then be sent a zoom link for the session. This is unique to you and should not be shared.
- You are not required to use the video function to show yourself if you feel more comfortable without.
- You can use the chat function to communicate to the group and host, but you are unable to DM other attendees.
- If it is a large group **everyone's** microphones will be muted unless invited to speak and **given the option to 'raise their hand' in order to contribute and respond to the session verbally.**
- Sessions are delivered by artists and moderated by a member of the CAC Learning Team.
- As host, CAC staff will use the function to remove anyone who willingly engages in any disruptive behaviour, or disrespect towards other participants or breaches guidelines.

Discord

- Sharing Space will take place over Discord (<https://discordapp.com/>)
- Discord is a free online platform and you will be sent a link to sign-up once you have registered for YCO. Again, this is unique to you and should not be shared.
- You will be asked to sign up for an account using your email address.
- This is a space where discussion is led by Youth Collective Online community, and we have two hosts who are member of the YCO community to welcome you.
- The CAC Learning Team monitors the platform regularly, to ensure it remains a safe and inclusive environment.
